

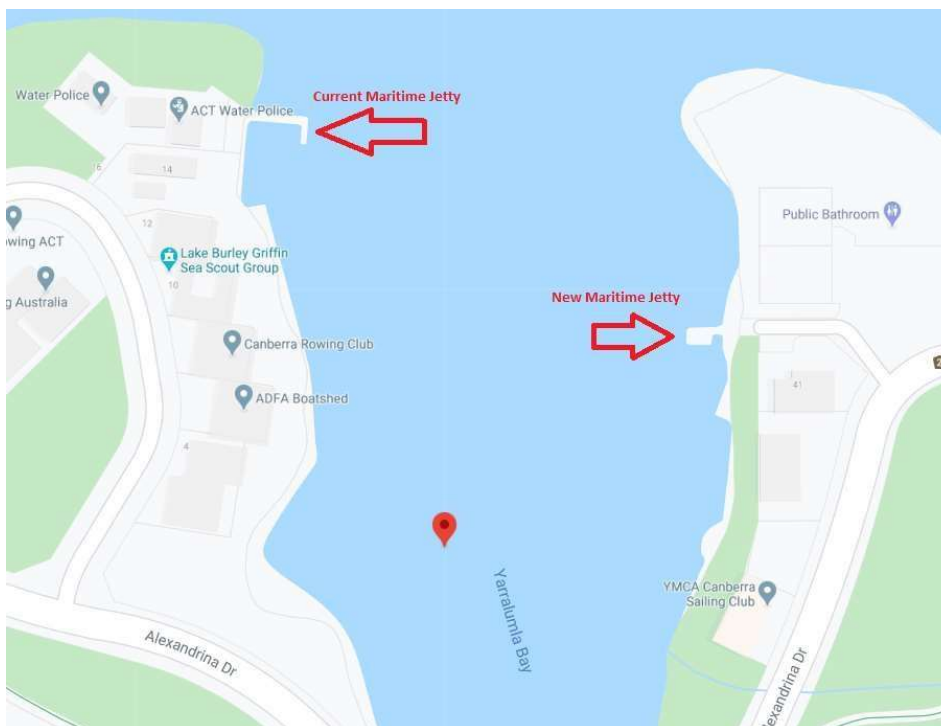
Relocation of ACT Maritime Services in Yarralumla Bay

The Australian Federal Police (AFP) is in the final stages of negotiating relocation of AFP Maritime Services to a new premises on Lake Burley Griffin in Yarralumla. This relocation will ensure the provision of maritime services to the ACT continues to support public safety on the water in a contemporary facility.

AFP Maritime is equipped to provide swift water rescue, tactical boarding and proactive patrolling in support of ACT Policing and the broader AFP.

Through consultation and negotiation with the National Capital Authority, the AFP intends to transfer berthing and vessel support activities in Yarralumla Bay from the Western Jetty to the Eastern Jetty. When AFP Maritime transfers to the Eastern Jetty, public access will be restricted to ensure security of the vessels, however at the same time public access to the Western Jetty will be fully reinstated.
